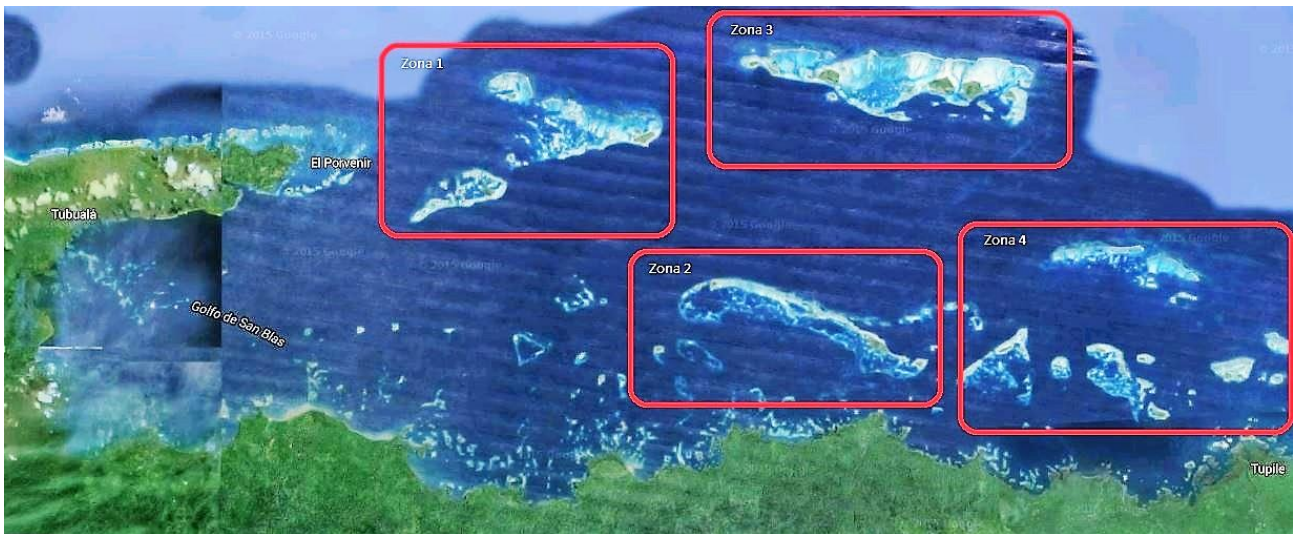
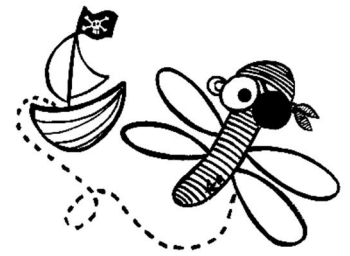


DESTINOS EN SAN BLAS



Zone 1. Lemon Cays

This group of islands are mostly untouched. The cays are ideal to explore and practice snorkeling thanks to the variety of coral reefs. The islands of tropical landscapes impress all visitors.

Zone 2. Green Island

Zone 3. Dutch Cays

Zone 4. Coco Bandero Cays

The archipelago of Coco Bandero Cay is a group of very picturesque islands, located behind a exterior barrier protected by a four miles long reef. This group of uninhabited islands may be the most beautiful of the San Blas archipelago, with its white sand beaches, tall palm trees and turquoise waters.
